Lifewater works with indigenous teams and partners on the ground in developing nations so that we can get water purification kits to people in need as quickly and cost effectively as possible.



Mission report

After severe flooding in Sindh, Pakistan the Christian minority were being discriminated against in the aid and relief efforts. To make this mission possible we partnered with an organisation called Open Doors International who works with the persecuted Church worldwide.

The aim of the mission was to distribute water purification kits to people in the southern Punjab and Sindh area where water pollution as a result of the severe flooding was at its worst. Following this kits were distributed to the relief camps in Khyber Pakhtunwah, as part of the Christian relief package.

The recipients were very pleased with the effectiveness of the kits, the ease with which they are installed and the instant access to clean and safe drinking water.
